

An mbeidh seirbhís éifeachtach agat?

Tá sibh i dteideal na seirbhísí seo faoin Chairt Eorpach do Theangacha Réigiúnda nó Mionlaigh. Dhaingnigh an Bhreatain 36 mír maidir leis an Gaeilge. Caithfidh áisín-teachtaí poiblí seirbhís a chur ar fáil – cé go dtig leo go fóill scríobh chugat as Béarla. Is doiciméad beo í an Chairt agus cuirfear léi sa todhchaí de réir éilimh. Mar sin, tá sé tábhachtach go mbainfidh muid tairbhe as na cearta a bheireann sí orainn anois.

Beidh POBAL ag déanamh monatóireachta ar chur i gcrích na Cairte. I dtaca leis seo, beidh an-tábhacht ag baint le haiseolas chun measúnú a dhéanamh ar thionchar na Cairte ar sholáthar seirbhísí.

Will you get a proper service?

You are entitled to these services by right under the European Charter for Regional or Minority Languages. The British government have ratified 36 clauses for Irish. Government agencies must provide some services, though they may choose to write to you in English. The Charter is a live document and it will be developed further in the future according to demand. It is, therefore, important that we utilise those rights it bestows on us now.

POBAL will be monitoring the implementation of the Charter. In this regard feedback is important so we can consider the impact of the Charter on services through the medium of Irish.

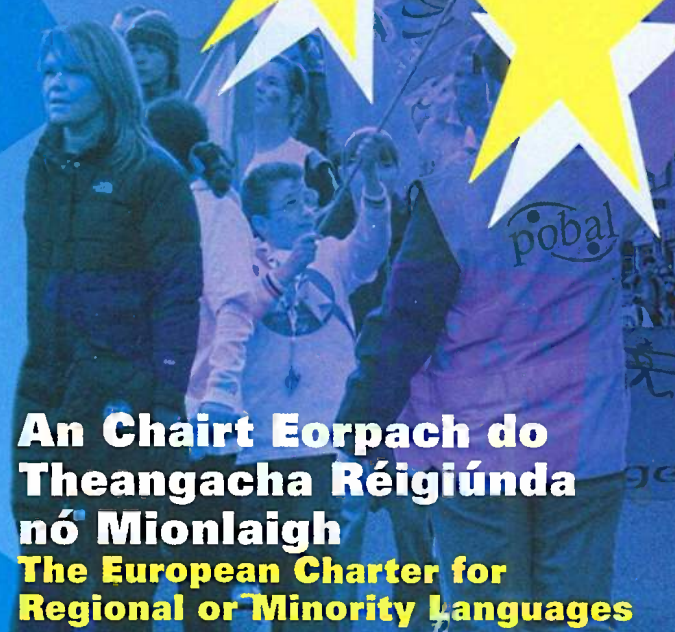

An bhfuil a fhios agat go bhfuil tú i dteideal seirbhísí trí mheán na Gaeilge ón earnáil phoiblí agus áisín-teachtaí rialtais?

Is féidir leat:

- litreacha a scríobh as Gaeilge, agus foirmeacha iarratais a líonadh as Gaeilge
- glaonna fóin as Gaeilge a dhéanamh nó labhairt leo as Gaeilge
- aistritheoir a iarraidh le linn cruinnithe rialtais nó leis an earnáil phoiblí
- roinnt doiciméad oifigiúil a fháil trí mheán na Gaeilge
- úsáid a bhaint as leagan Gaeilge d'ainmneacha pearsanta
- úsáid a bhaint as leagan traidisiúnta de logainmneacha

Did you know that you are entitled to some Irish language services from public bodies and government agencies?

You can:

- Write letters and fill in forms in Irish
- Speak to, or telephone them, in Irish
- Have a translator at meetings with government and public bodies
- Receive some official documents in Irish
- Use your personal name in Irish
- Use traditional place names in Irish

If there is a street light broken in your area, report it through the medium of Irish

If there are difficulties with refuse collection, make your complaint through the medium of Irish

If you are making an application for funding from a government agency, write in Irish
